## Deadline

- Regular Decision Deadline: March 1

## Accelerated Dual Degree Notes

- 1 Major-specific essay
- Optional documented healthcare experience (recommended)
- Interview required for selected DPT & OTD candidates

# Financial Aid

- Merit Scholarships
  - Based on high school academics
  - First-Year students eligible for up to \$26,000/year
